WELCOME MESSAGE From the Program Chair

Dear Teachers, Colleagues & Friends,

When Dr. Kapil Dua asked me to be the Program Chair for the 31st World Congress well over a year ago, the wheels were set in motion for what now makes up the scientific program. As soon as I accepted the role, I started to think about how I could design an educational offering that would be truly memorable and one that would match, and do justice to, the magnificence of India and the cultural program that attendees will enjoy. Not every World Congress has had a theme, but I liked the idea of having one, so I chose **The Hair Follicle - From Beginning to End**.

After all, the hair follicle is what we deal with day in day out, and transplanting it is how most of us make a living. We have a lot to thank this amazing organ for and we should try to understand it as much as we can. We should not just focus on the technicalities involved in the quickest and best way to move it intact from its donor location to its recipient site, we should also know what its embryological origins are, what keeps it healthy or makes it diseased, how it is regulated, what we can do to optimise its growth, how it ages and deteriorates, as well as what are the opportunities for regenerating it. This meant fewer abstracts could be accepted for oral presentation and is part of the reason why the time allocation for each talk is so short. We had the most abstracts submitted this year since 2013 and many deserving ones will not be showcased in the general sessions but do feature in the **Cases, Studies and Innovations (CSIs)**, teasers of which can be seen in the CSI Highlights 55 second video compilations. Please take the time to watch these and to view the CSIs in more detail. You will miss out on some fantastic presentations if you don't.

I always feel that I am being cheated when there are overlapping focus sessions so this year there will be a single **Lunch Symposium** on each day that are not to be missed! Grab your tasty lunch and head back to the Pearl Ballroom to learn while you eat!

Make sure also to join in the **Round Table Chats and view the Live Patients** in the same session. This is a chance to interact with experts in small groups and to explore specific topics in much greater depth than is possible in the General Sessions. Early post op patients from the AHRS India Live Surgery Workshop will be present for close up examination as well as a variety of other interesting patients.

I put in a great deal of time researching and writing my twelve ISHRS newsletter and six Forum messages over the past year on a variety of destinations and subjects about 'Incredible India' - I hope you enjoyed reading them and that you have a wonderful experience in Delhi. 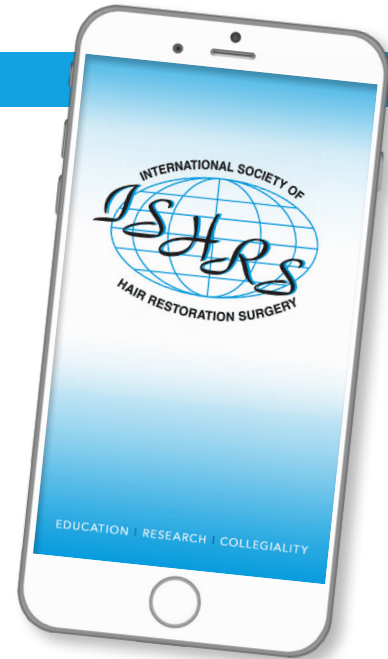
The use of cellular phones in the General Session or workshop rooms is strictly prohibited. Attendees must either turn off or vibrate cellular phones.

Building on almost 35 years of research into wound healing and scarring, this long standing unit provides a strong foundation for young doctors who set out to pursue a career in Plastic Surgery and encourages them to embark on innovative research projects that generate evidence for practising evidence-based medicine. The unit has trained a number of research fellows over the years, with many now working as established consultants in various parts of the UK.

As a Senior Lecturer in Biomedical Sciences, she teaches undergraduate and graduate students, and has a number of Ph.D. students working under her supervision. She is the option convenor for the Cellular Pathology specialist option in the final year of the undergraduate Biomedical Sciences programme and the the module leader for the level 6 module, Research Topics in Medical Cell Biology.

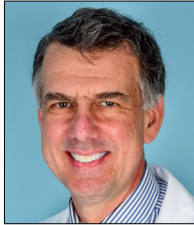

Maria Kasper is Associate Professor at the Karolinska Institute in Stockholm, Sweden. She received her PhD at the University of Salzburg in human genetics and molecular tumor biology. In 2013, after a 6-year postdoctoral training in skin biology, she established her laboratory in the field of skin stem cell dynamics, tissue regeneration, and single cell transcriptomics. The Kasper Lab studies spatiotemporal processes to investigate how skin regenerates, cell-lineage decisions are made, wounds heal, and epithelial tumours initiate. Dr. Kasper has received national and international recognitions for her work, such as the Swedish Cancer Society Young Investigator Award, Ragnar Söderberg Fellow in Medicine and the LEO Gold Award and is a main coordinator of the Human Cell Atlas SKIN bionetwork.

O'Tar T. Norwood

The Norwood Lectureship pays tribute to O'Tar Norwood, MD, an Oklahoma physician who had a long and successful career in dermatology. At the time of writing his first book on Hair Transplant Surgery in 1973, he was Clinical Assistant Professor of Dermatology at the University of Oklahoma

Medical School, USA. Amongst other things he was a Founding Member of the American Society for Dermatologic Surgery and with Dr. Dow Stough he was instrumental in gathering like-minded doctors in 1992 to form the ISHRS. O'Tar was a restless thinker who brought together people and ideas to explain the MPHL process. His letters and communications were so numerous that he started a magazine called the Hair Transplant Forum International. It grew very quickly and became so popular that everyone wanted to read it and contribute articles. Soon after, O'Tar donated the magazine to the ISHRS. Its descendant is the ever-popular Forum we read today. O'Tar continued to publish and teach at our conferences for many years. His name is etched in our history. Those who knew O'Tar fondly remember the informal moments after lectures where his wit and joy for life were wonderful to share. He would welcome all with his cheeky warm smile.

Dow B. Stough

The Stough Lectureship recognizes an individual with vision and a demonstrated passion for education. Established in 2019, the Stough Lecture honors ISHRS Co-founder Dow Stough, MD, who in the early 1990's recognized that the fractured, chaotic, and often secretive world

of hair restoration needed an anchor. The founding of the ISHRS in 1993 brought order to chaos, turned competitors into colleagues, and created an educational organization that has changed the face and improved the outcomes of hair restoration throughout the world. A very well-respected dermatologist from Hot Springs, Arkansas, USA, Dr. Stough was one of the earliest proponents of follicular unit transplantation and natural looking hairlines, and his focus on innovation and teaching is evidenced by Dow being the youngest President, Program Chair, Golden Follicle Award winner, and Manfred Lucas Award winner in ISHRS history. He is a true leader and his contagious enthusiasm has inspired and motivated many hair transplant surgeons. 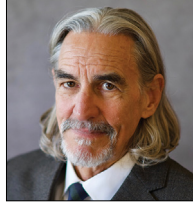

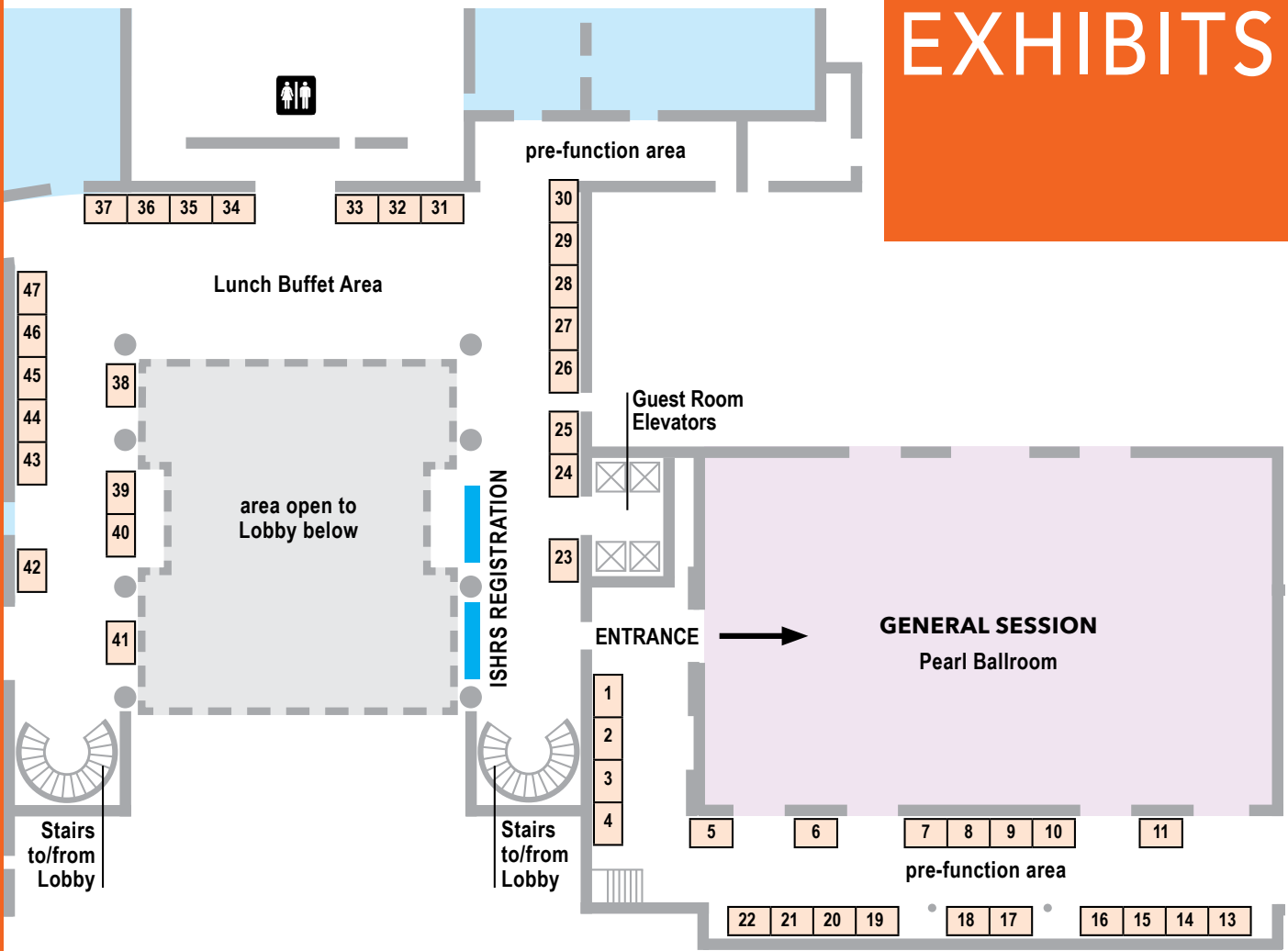

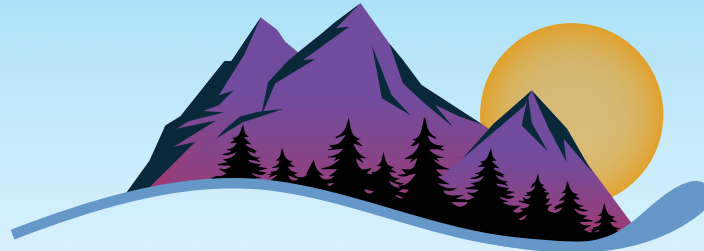
